Imogen Cunningham is only 87. She's been involved in photography since 1901, and this year received a Guggenheim fellowship to make enlargements of her "forgotten" photos taken during the past seventy years. "I haven't printed these pictures since my platinum (print) days, and there hasn't been any platinum around since 1917; I had completely forgotten about them."

The photographs were taken in 1915 during an excursion to Mt. Ranier, in Washington. "It wasn't like it is now—then you could skip around without any clothes on and nobody would bother you."
